Dear Chatham Borough Residents:

The situation with the COVID-19 virus is evolving rapidly.

After discussing the matter carefully with members of the Coronavirus Task Force, I have decided to issue an order closing all parks and athletic fields within the Borough effective immediately and until further notice. While our parks and fields are a great asset in normal times, unfortunately they are also a place where people continue to congregate in close, large groups and have close physical contact.

While no official directives have been made regarding other gatherings, I would like to urge all residents to take seriously the prescription laid out by health officials for social distancing.
