RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO CLOSE CERTAIN DESIGNATED PARKING LOTS AND ROADS AND TO CONTROL AND REGULATE TRAFFIC CONDITIONS CONSEQUENT THERETO FOR THE 2017 FISHAWACK FESTIVAL

WHEREAS, the 2017 Fishawack Festival will be held on June 10, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has reviewed the proposed layout of vendors, kiosks, car show and other planned activities for the 2017 Fishawack Festival and has made recommendations to the Borough Administrator that certain designated parking lots and roads should be closed in efforts to control and regulate traffic conditions consequent thereto for the event.
