RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF CHATHAM AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE OPERATION OF A JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham, the Township of Chatham, the Township of Harding, the Borough of Madison, and the Township of Morris have indicated a desire to renew their participation to operate a Joint Municipal Court, known as "The Joint Municipal Court of Madison, the Chathams, Harding and Morris Township" and to utilize the court facilities at the Hartley Dodge Memorial (Madison Borough Hall) at Kings Road in Madison in accordance with the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Municipal Court Agreement shall expire on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, participation in the Joint Municipal Court will result in financial savings to the Borough and will provide for the efficient administration of justice; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council deems it appropriate to authorize renewal into an agreement for a Joint Municipal Court with the Borough of Madison, the Township of Chatham, the Township of Harding and the Township of Morris for a three (3) year period, beginning January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2010, subject to the concurrence and approval of the Assignment Judge, Superior Court of New Jersey, Morris County.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Chatham, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for participation in the operation of said Joint Municipal Court; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the execution of the Joint Municipal Court Agreement, the Borough Clerk shall forward a copy of the signed agreement, together with a certified copy of the authorizing Resolution to the Township of Chatham, the Township of Harding, the Borough of Madison, and the Township of Morris; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Borough employees and officials are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary and appropriate to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
