## **Post Office Plaza Town Hall Meetings Rescheduled**

The Chatham Borough Mayor and Council have decided that it would be in the best interest of all involved to adjust the Post Office Plaza Town Hall meeting schedule and postpone the Monday, March 21<sup>st</sup> meeting until Wednesday, March 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 pm. The rescheduled event will take place at the Chatham Middle School auditorium (480 Main Street).

In addition, the Borough will now offer two official Town Halls as part of the deliberative process. This will afford the public a period for which to examine the presented options following their introduction on March 30<sup>th</sup> and prior to the second public discussion on Monday, April 4<sup>th</sup>.

Accordingly, the adjusted schedule is as follows:

- The First Town Hall will be held on Wednesday, March 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 pm in the Chatham Middle School auditorium.
- The Second Town Hall will be held on Monday, April 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 pm in the Chatham Middle School auditorium.
- The Council Vote will take place at a Special Borough Council Meeting on Monday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, most likely in the Borough Hall Council Chambers at 7:30pm.

Mayor Kobylarz indicated that the Council Vote on April 18<sup>th</sup> will be to select a general option for Post Office Plaza only, with further details pertaining to such matters as design, financial agreements, etc. to be discussed at additional Town Halls (as needed).

The Borough is therefore committed to a continuing dialogue with the public to further refine the selected project. As with last year's deliberation in the case of the River Road project, multiple Town Halls are envisioned once the general scope for Post Office Plaza has been determined.
