AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CHATHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 139, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 36 SCHEDULE XIV: LEFT TURN PROHIBITIONS, OF THE BOROUGH CODE

WHEREAS, Chapter 139, Vehicles and Traffic, Section 36, Schedule XIV: Left-Turn Prohibitions, of the Borough Code sets forth the locations within the Borough that left turns are prohibited; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the best interests of and will protect and promote the health, safety and welfare of the Borough of Chatham and its residents that Chapter 139 Section 36 of the Borough Code be amended to delete certain locations from the Schedule;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Chatham, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1:

1. Chapter 139 of the Borough Code, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, is hereby amended as follows, with additional provisions underlined and deleted provisions ~~stricken through~~

§ 139-36. Schedule XIV: Left-Turn Prohibitions.

In accordance with the provisions of § 139-20, no person shall make a left turn at any of the following locations:

Street	Direction of Travel
Bowers Lane	North on Bowers Lane to west on Main Street
Center Street	South on Center Street to east on Main Street
Coleman Avenue	Exiting 322 Main Street

Elmwood Avenue	South on Elmwood Avenue to east on Main Street, Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Lackawanna Avenue	South on Lackawanna Avenue to east on River Road
Lafayette Avenue	South on Lafayette Avenue, at the Commerce Bank site entrance
River Road	East on River Road to north on Lackawanna Avenue
Roosevelt Avenue	South on Roosevelt Avenue to east on Main Street
Tallmadge Avenue	North on Tallmadge Avenue to west on Main Street

Section 2.

All other provisions of Chapter 139 not amended herein remain in full force and effect.

Section 3.

If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

Section 4.

Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

Section 5.

This Ordinance shall take effect on upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
