RESOLUTION #15-191 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE MADISON AREA YMCA, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$27,571.00

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham desires to engage the Madison Area YMCA ("YMCA") to provide certain cognitive behavioral counseling services to children and teens attending Chatham schools and/or living in Chatham Borough and their families ("Borough residents"); and

WHEREAS, the YMCA desires to render said cognitive behavioral counseling services to Borough residents as set forth in the Service Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the maximum contract amount shall not exceed \$27,571.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has confirmed that sufficient funds are available in Current Fund Account #5-01-25-240-298 for the award of this contract.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Chatham that the Mayor and Borough Clerk be, and hereby are, authorized to execute a Service Agreement with the YMCA to provide certain

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CHATHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF EASEMENT ENCROACHMENT AGREEMENT WITH MINISINK CLUB, INC.

WHEREAS, the Minisink Club, Inc. (the "Club") is the owner in fee simple of certain lands and premises located in the Borough of Chatham, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, commonly known as Block 43, Lot 1 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough holds an easement and right of way over the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Club desires to construct and maintain a paddle tennis court together with all necessary improvements, fittings, appurtenances and facilities which will encroach onto the Borough's easement; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council is willing to permit the encroachment into the Borough's easement subject to certain terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, these terms and conditions shall be set forth in an agreement, which shall be in substantially the same form as the Easement Encroachment Agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof this Resolution; and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Chatham in the County of Morris and the State of New Jersey that the Mayor and Borough Clerk be and hereby are authorized to execute the Easement Encroachment Agreement in substantially the same form as the agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Attorney be and hereby is authorized to negotiate the final form of the Easement Encroachment Agreement with counsel for the Club and take such other action as necessary to implement this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough's execution of the Easement Encroachment Agreement is contingent on the Club reimbursing the Borough for its costs in preparing, reviewing, executing and recording this Agreement in accordance with Paragraph 14 of the Agreement and on the Club receiving all other agency approvals, including Borough Zoning Board approval, for the proposed encroachment.

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has confirmed that sufficient funds are available in General Capital Fund Account #C-04-55-914-106 for the award of this contract.
