RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A FIVE (5) YEAR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES CONTRACT TO SUBURBAN DISPOSAL, INC.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham solicited bid proposals from qualified bidders interested in providing solid waste collection services for a five (5) year contract term commencing on March 30, 2016 and ending on March 30, 2021, in accordance with the terms of the Borough's Bid Specifications and N.J.A.C. 7:26H-6 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, bid proposals were received from B&B Disposal, LLC and Suburban Disposal, Inc. and were publicly opened by the Borough Clerk and Borough Attorney on October 20, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the bid proposals and accompanying documents were reviewed by the Borough Attorney to ensure compliance with all statutory, regulatory, and Bid Specification requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough and its residents to award the base bid as set forth in the Bid Specifications; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the bid submitted by Suburban Disposal, Inc., 54 Montesano Road, Fairfield, NJ, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with an aggregate base bid of \$1,498,000 and base bid for each contract year as follows:
